Dear Friends of Trickey Pond,

The Board is pleased to report that in 2023 the TPEPA made strides towards our ongoing efforts to protect the water quality and watershed of Trickey Pond, in this our 17th year.

Accomplishments include:

- Funded 549 hours of courtesy boat inspections
- Awarded a \$2300 MDEP Invasive Cost Share Grant
- Completed watershed projects in year two of the EPA 319 Grant to address non-point source pollution
- Gained approval to extend the EPA 319 Grant for a third year to address additional projects
- Funded and maintained the boat wash station
- Funded invasive plant survey of Trickey Pond

As a donor-funded nonprofit organization we primarily rely on the contributions of the property owners around Trickey Pond. In 2023 we received some new first-time donations as we continue to work towards increasing our donor base.

The TPEPA is an all volunteer lake association and we are most grateful for the expertise and resources provided to us by Lakes Environmental Association (LEA), Maine DEP, and Cumberland County Soil & Water Conservation District (CCSWCD). LEA is instrumental in managing the Courtesy Boat Inspection program at the public launch and in conducting water testing. CCSWCD and MDEP provide leadership for the EPA Grant work. Many thanks to those organizations and to all who support our mission.

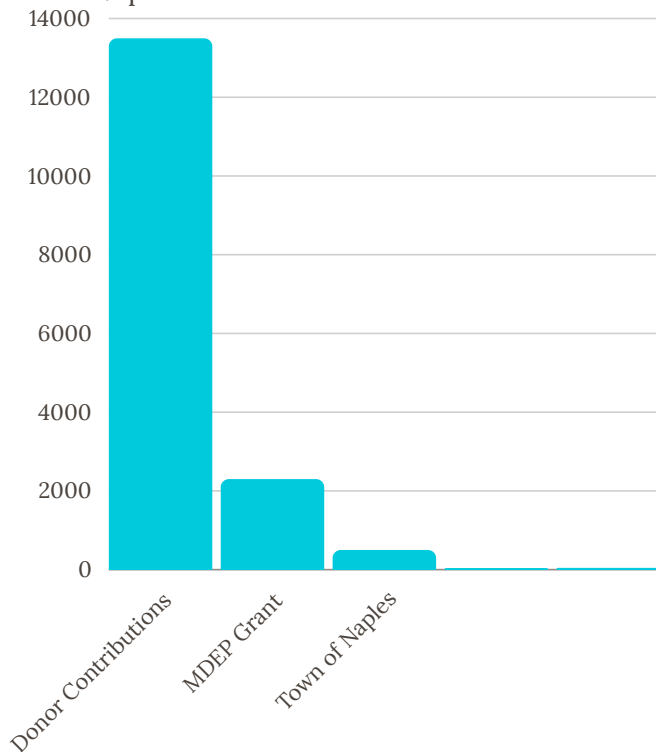


FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

TPEPA, a Maine nonprofit corporation, is granted 501(c)(3) status by the IRS as a nonprofit charitable organization.

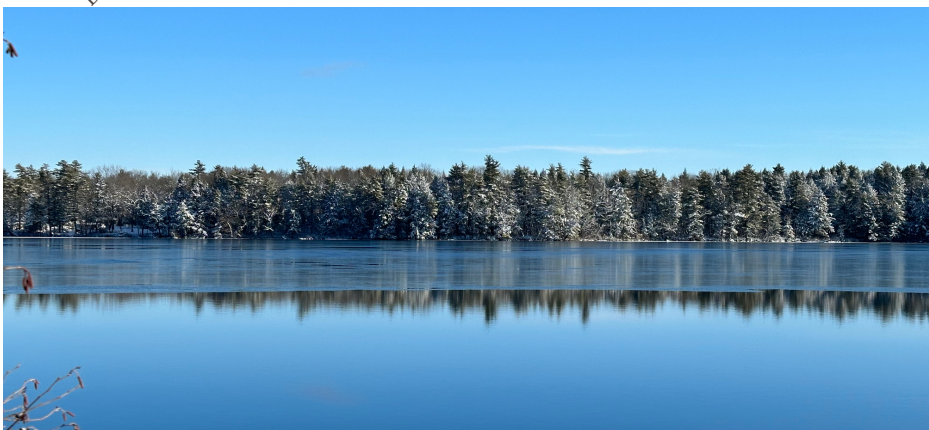
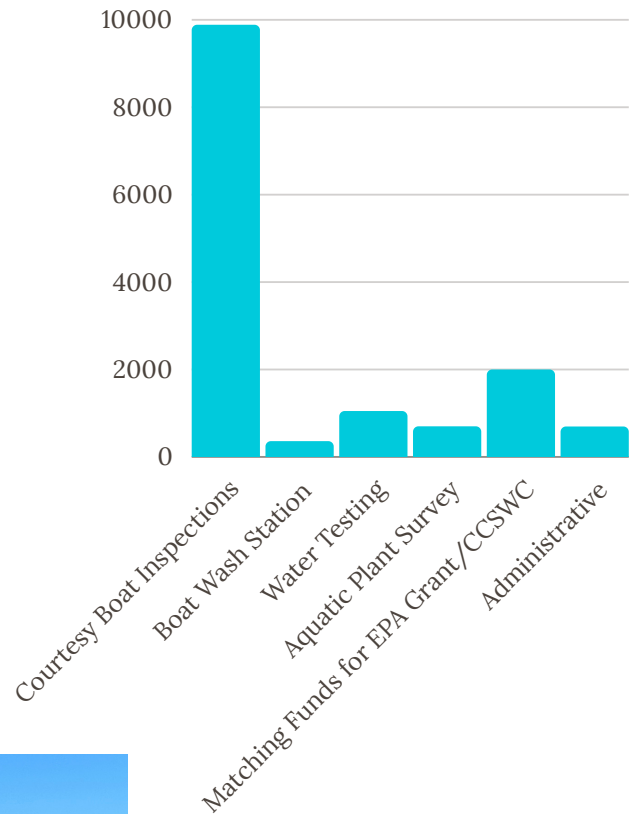
REVENUE
